
This document describes how to download and install VirtualBox 4.3.20 on a Windows 7 Professional Service pack 1 (64-bit) Host.

3 Download VirtualBox

VirtualBox 4.3.20 can be downloaded from VirtualBox

Click on the “VirtualBox 4.3.20 for Windows hosts” “amd64” hyperlink and save to “I:\syfer\Downloads”

 - SHA256 checksums or the
 - MDS checksums
- to verify the integrity of downloaded packages.
- The SHA256 checksums should be favored as the MDS algorithm must be treated as insecure!
- Note:** After upgrading VirtualBox it is recommended to upgrade the guest additions as well.

Click on the “Next” button.

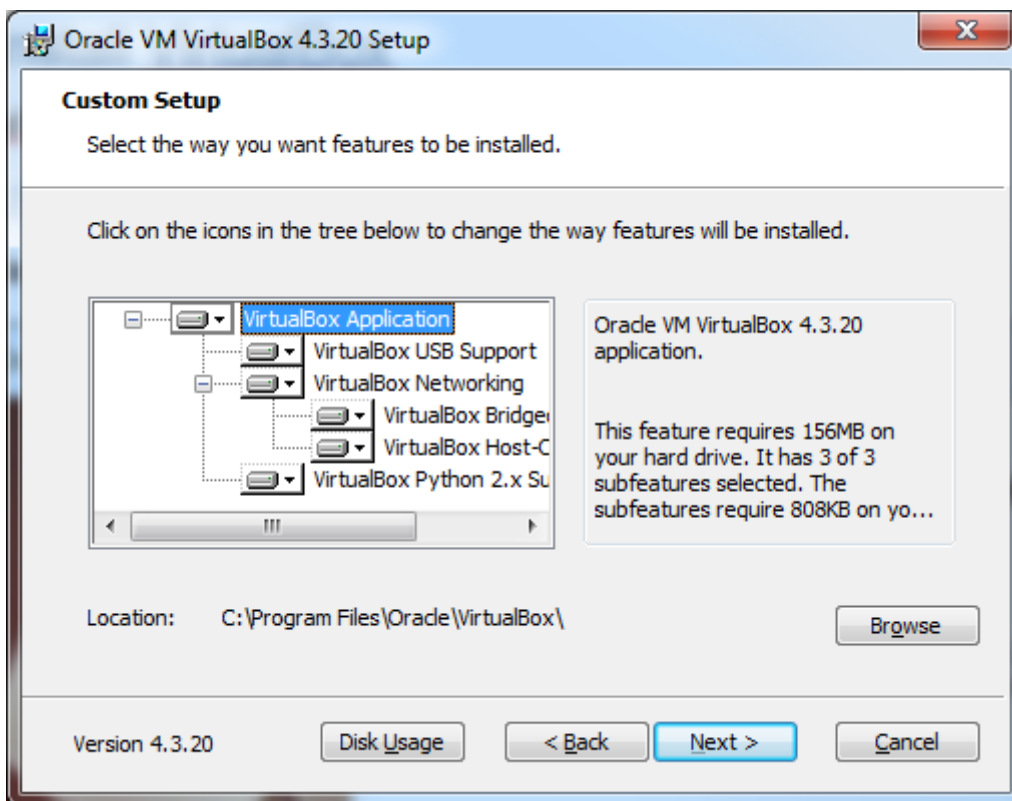


Figure 3: Oracle VM VirtualBox Install – Custom Setup 1

Click on the “Next” button.

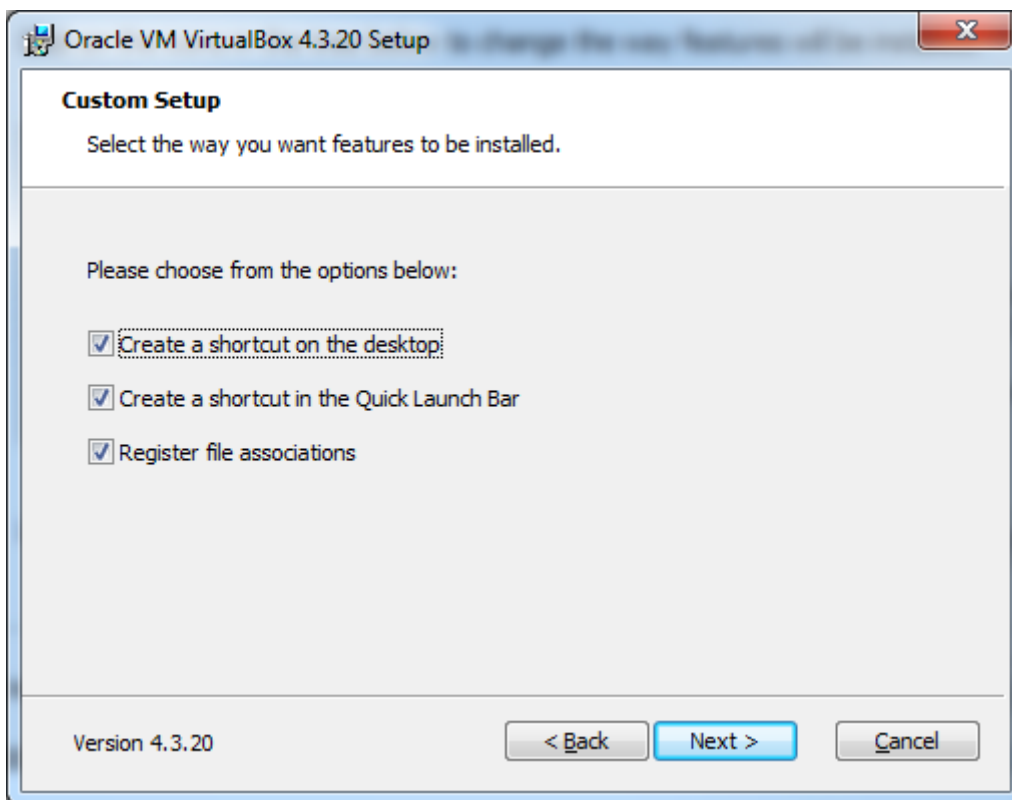


Figure 4: Oracle VM VirtualBox Install – Custom Setup 2

Click on the “Install” button.

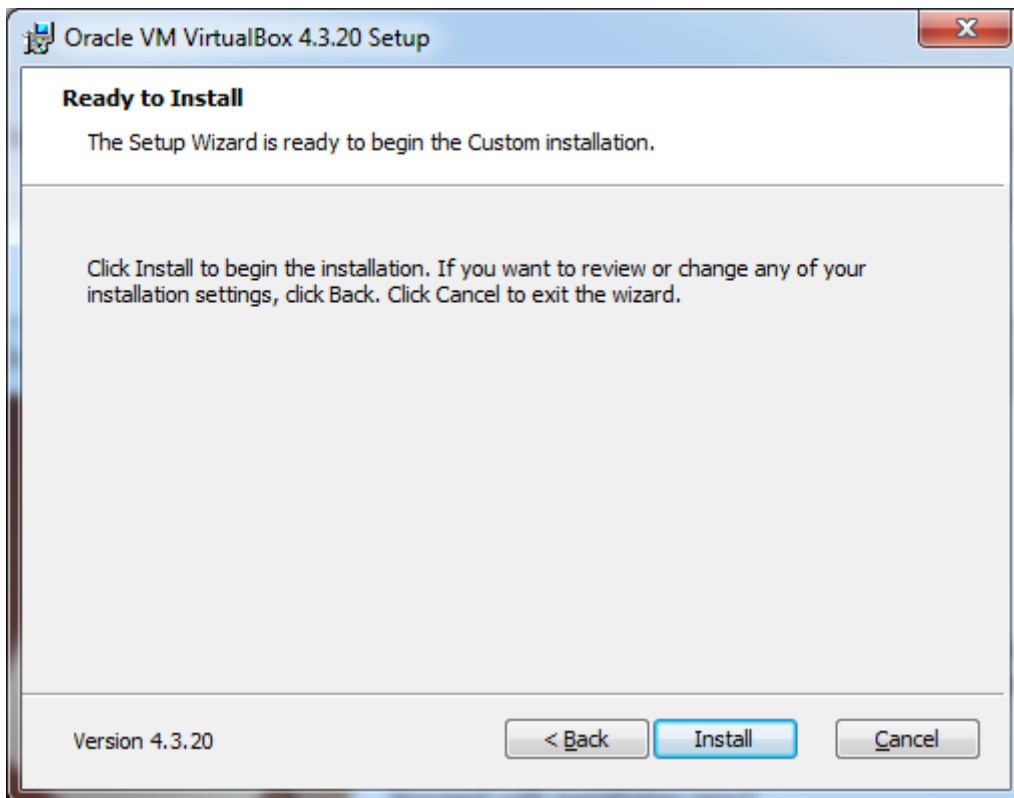


Figure 6: Oracle VM VirtualBox Install - Ready to Install

“Start -> All Programs -> Oracle VM VirtualBox -> Oracle VM VirtualBox”

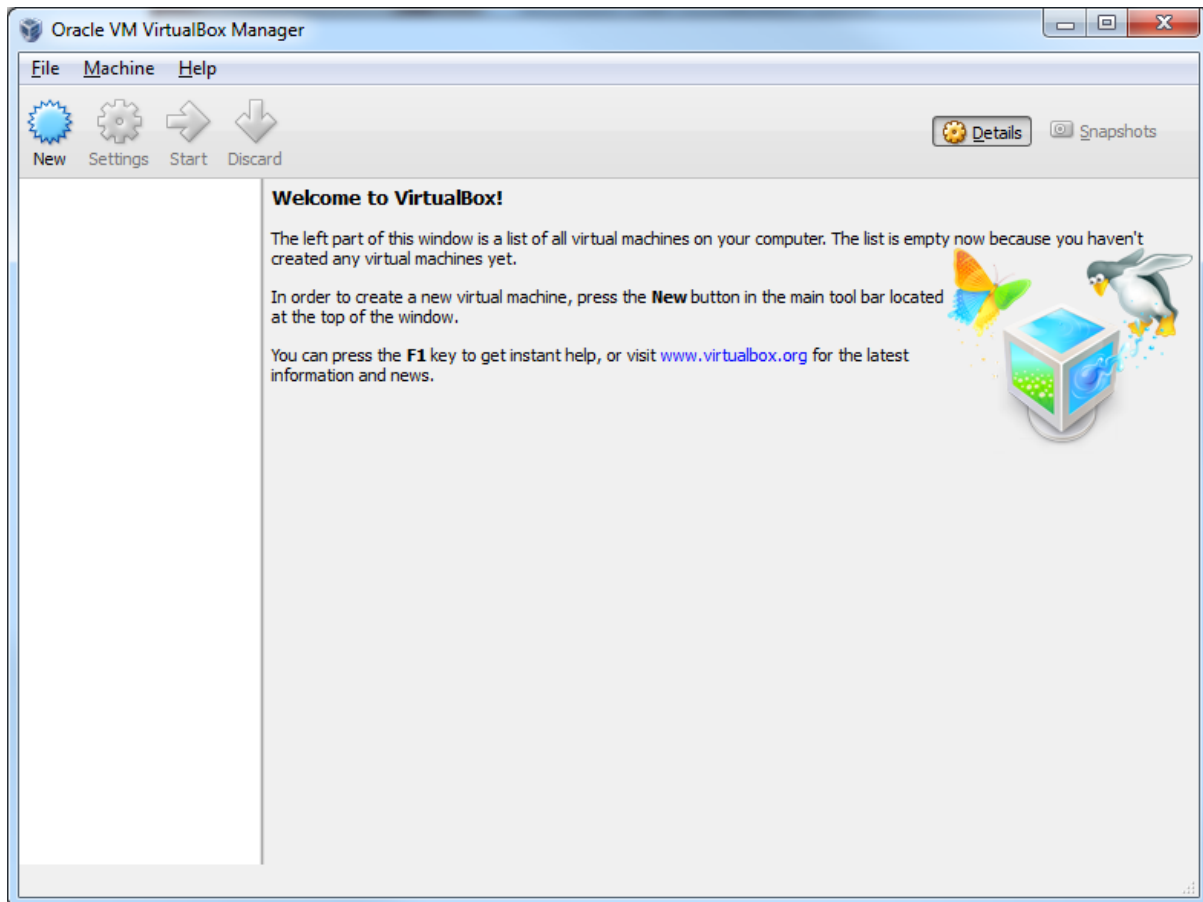


Figure 8: Oracle VM VirtualBox Manager
